  - iii) 2 अंकों के लिए – एक प्री-बोर्ड परीक्षा आयोजित की जाएगी जिसका अंतिम आंतरिक मूल्यांकन के लिए 02 अंकों का भारांक होगा।
  - iv) 2 अंकों के लिए – विषय शिक्षक CRP (कक्षा कक्ष की भागीदारी ) लिए मूल्यांकन करेंगे और अधिकतम 02 अंक देंगे।
  - v) 5 अंकों के लिए – छात्रों द्वारा एक परियोजना कार्य किया जाएगा जिसका अंतिम आंतरिक मूल्यांकन के लिए 05 अंकों का भारांक होगा।
  - vi) 5 अंकों के लिए – विद्यार्थी की उपस्थिति के निम्नानुसार 05 अंक प्रदान किए जाएँगे : -

75% से 80% तक – 01 अंक

80% से अधिक से 85% तक – 02 अंक

85% से अधिक से 90% तक – 03 अंक

90% से अधिक से 95% तक – 04 अंक

- v) For 5 marks- Attendance of student will be awarded 05 marks as:


