There are different kinds of vegetables. They may be edible roots, stems, leaves, fruits and seeds. Each group contributes to diet in its own way. Roots are high in energy value and good sources of vitamin-B group. Seeds are relatively high in Carbohydrates and Proteins. Leaves, Stems and fruits are excellent sources of minerals, vitamins, water and roughage. An intake of about 280 grams of vegetables per day is considered essential for maintenance of good health. Of this, leafy vegetables should constitute 40 percent, roots and tubers 30 percent and the other vegetables like brinjals and lady fingers, the remaining 30 percent.
